E-TRACK/RWM 2nd Open Seminar The German Case

The Seminar will provide a unique opportunity to learn from the insight and experience of a broad diversity of actors and interested parties in the management of radioactive waste in Germany. Representatives of government, municipalities, industry, social platforms, environmental organisations and academic experts will convey a multifaceted and comprehensive outlook on past and ongoing decision-making processes and will present a diversity of views and proposals to enhance participation and transparency in the future.

R&Dialogue Event

During this event we will present local and national lessons from low carbon dialogues we have organised in 10 European countries. The aim is to interact on dialogue and the challenges to get broad participation in the energy transition. It will be a day of exchange with key Brussels stakeholders and national representatives. Participants will get new insights on how we can work together in Europe to realise the energy transition. Structure: thematic dialogue sessions in the morning and a panel session on the future of low carbon dialogue in Europe in the afternoon.

E-TRACK Launch

Combined in the afternoon session with the R&Dialogue event, the official launch of E-TRACK will take place. Together with the intervention of senior officials of the European Commission, there will be an overview on the social dimensions of different energy technologies, such as carbon capture storage or wind generation.
